**Marzano Instructional Framework**

District-level Training for New Teachers and Teachers New to Cheney. These teachers will partner with their mentors through the New Teacher Induction year-long process. During no fewer than three New Teacher Round-Tables, the focus will be on TPEP training.

Building-based Training. In addition, the District TPEP Leadership Team will support the building-level leadership team to provide for a monthly Friday collaboration for the teacher TPEP participants at their site. Participation in the building-level training sessions is encouraged; the content will be based upon feedback from TPEP teachers working with building administrators and the TPEP Teacher Leader for the school site, as well as the year-end Professional Development Needs Survey from the previous year. Training at the building level will include:

- eVal tool (where appropriate) – within the first 3 weeks of school
- Self-assessment support
- Fall, Winter, and Spring roving sub-out days for building-level TPEP work on goal-setting, monitoring progress, evidence conversations, learning walks, etc.

**Student Growth Criterion**

Years 2 and 3 TPEPers may attend more than one of the following training sessions. The trainings will focus on Criterion 3, 6, and 8. All TPEP participants may benefit from participation in these training sessions and/or may be asked to attend by their evaluators.
