FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESK

One of the things I've been intentional in talking with our students about recently is the importance of respecting others and avoiding negativity. Critical attitudes and deliberate vocal statements of unwillingness to participate can quickly become a poison that discourages an entire class. Worse yet, it isn't productive for learning and spiritual growth. It doesn't benefit students, teachers or the learning process. I would invite you to have a conversation with your child this week regarding the importance of intentionally encouraging and respecting others, participating complaining, and avoiding belittling comments to peers even in a joking way.

"People don't know we are here! How is that possible?" Recently an astounded student approached me and asked those very questions. They share that while sitting at McDonalds in Plain City recently they had encountered a local family who has lived in Plain City all their lives, but had no idea Shekinah Christian School even existed.
