

**LAKE ELSINORE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT  
KINDERGARTEN ENROLLMENT  
2018/19 School Year**

**The following documents are required for enrollment:**

1. **Birth Certificate** - (child must be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2018)  
Documents verifying age, in order of desirability: birth certificate, baptismal certificate, passport, or Bible record.
2. **Proof of Residency** - Current utility bill (dated within the past 60 days), i.e. water, gas, electric, disposal service, rental agreement, lease. If living in the residence of another person, a Residency Affidavit from that person verifying the living situation must accompany the above verification at time of enrollment. The actual resident must also be present at the time of registration.
3. **Immunizations/Shots** - **Evidence of completed required immunizations**  
**\*\* Students with incomplete immunizations will not be enrolled (Senate Bill 277) \*\***
  - a. 4 POLIO (3 if last dose given after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)
  - b. 5 DTP (4 if last dose given after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)
  - c. 2 MMR (first dose must be given on or after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday)
  - d. 3 HEPATITIS B
  - e. VARICELLA shot OR proof of chickenpox disease verified by MD
4. **Physical Exam** - **MUST BE DATED AFTER 2-13-18**
5. **Oral Health Assessment** - **MUST BE DATED AFTER 8-13-17** To make sure your child is ready for school, California Law, Ed Code Section 49452.8 now requires that your child have an oral health assessment (dental check-up) by May 31 in either kindergarten or first grade, whichever is his or her first year in public school. Assessments that have been completed within the 12 months before your child enters school also meet this requirement. The law specifies that the assessment must be done by a licensed dentist or other licensed or registered dental health professional. District's Oral Health Assessment forms must be used.)
6. **Special Education** - A copy of your child's IEP is required IF your child receives special education services.

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- **At home** - Parents can complete an online registration application at any time from their own device beginning February 12, 2018.
- **At school site** - Parents can go to their school site to complete an online application. Parents should confirm with school site regarding hours of availability.
- **At District Office** - Parents can come to the District Office for assistance with an online application.
