

# Supplemental Educational Services (SES)

## Explanation of Services

Under the Federal Law, No Child Left Behind act, parents at a school site identified as a Program Improvement School for two years or more have a right to request Supplemental Educational Services. Choices for supplemental tutoring services outside the instructional day are available at designated school sites. Tutoring services are provided by private and non-profit companies approved by the state of California and contracted through Lucia Mar Unified School District. This is a federally funded program, with no cost to the parents. Transportation to tutorial services is the responsibility of the parent or guardian. In order for your child to be eligible for tutoring services, he/she must:

- Attend a school identified as a Program Improvement school year 2 or more.
- Qualify for Free and Reduced Lunch
- Be enrolled 1<sup>st</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade at eligible school sites
