### Be Informed!

- Be sure to use the SASEAS website ([www.saseasschool.org](http://www.saseasschool.org))! It's updated regularly, and loaded with great information.
- Subscribe to your child's teachers' webpage. This is where you will stay current on homework assignments, upcoming deadlines, classroom announcements and news!
- Read the Titan Times weekly! This is our online newsletter. It is the best place to find out what's happening at SASEAS School.
- Frequently access your child's online Option C account which includes their academic progress and grades.
- If you use Facebook, "Like" our school page.
- Follow us on Twitter.
- Become familiar with the SASEAS School Parent-Student Handbook. It will answer important questions such as dress code, attendance, grading, snow days, etc.
- Attend your child's Meet the Teacher Night (even if you have a child at both campuses).
- Conferences are an important part of teacher/parent communication. Please be sure to sign up and attend.

### Get Involved!

- Your time and talent is very much needed and appreciated (and your children love seeing you at their school).
- Attend the weekly Mass or prayer service with the students at the St. Andrew Campus or St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Campus. ## **Helpful Information!**

- Our uniform exchange program allows you to take uniform clothing you may need and donate your uniforms you can no longer use. This exchange is set up in the cafeteria several times throughout the year; however, you can contact the chairperson at anytime to add or take.
- Spirit Days are designated days for your child to come to school out of uniform, but dressed in spiritwear instead. Please check the Parent/Student Handbook for clarification.
- Out-of-Uniform days are scheduled at the discretion of the principal. They are usually awarded to individual students/classes for specific achievements or the entire school for fundraising purposes. Please check the Parent/Student Handbook for clarification.

- Check your child's academic progress often. Teachers update Option C regularly.
- Homework – check, even if your child says they have none.
- A teacher's email is usually the best way to communicate a concern or question. Don't wait to the last minute to do this. Teachers will respond within 24 hours.
