House Bill 984 outlines guidelines for implementation when it has been determined that there is a student with diabetes at the school campus. There are three training levels, and at this time we can label our staff as level 2- "Need to Know", This level of employee is associated with the student with diabetes, but is not a UDCA (Unlicensed Diabetic Care Assistant), however our level 2's have been trained with components of a level 3 UDCA, such as: training modules [www.diabetes.org/schooltraining](http://www.diabetes.org/schooltraining), taking the written test, and attending a meeting where all of the UDCA skills were demonstrated for them.
