



The Altoona Area School District has two ways (see below) to register your child for Kindergarten in the 2018-2019 school year. Please note the change in the registration cut-off date. Kindergarten children must turn 5 years old on or before September 1, 2018.

1. **ONLINE ~ Kindergarten Registration can be completed ONLINE. Visit [Kindergarten Registration](#) to begin the registration process. Upon completion of your on-line registration, you will be invited to attend an event and finalize the registration at your respective home school in March/April. A representative from your home school will contact you within 3 days to schedule an appointment at the school. If you do not receive a phone call, please call the school that you believe your child will attend for assistance.**
2. **HARD COPY PACKET ~ Kindergarten Registration can be completed with a HARD COPY PACKET. You can download and print this packet by going to [Kindergarten Registration](#). If you do not have access to a printer, please stop by any local school to pick up a packet and get started early. If you do not start early, you can fill out the packet at your respective home school at the registration event in March/April. Please call that school to schedule your appointment time. If you are unsure of your home school, please contact Student Registration at (814) 381-7585 or (814) 381-7586.**

All registrations will be finalized following the schedule on the back of this form. You and your child will be required to attend a session where you will meet with faculty and receive materials to help your child prepare for Kindergarten.



What the parent needs to bring (The parent or legal guardian must register the child):

- **Proof of Age** (Required by State Law and must be presented at time of registration. An official certificate of
 - birth is preferred. If this is not available, please bring a hospital certificate, baptismal certificate or the
 - ORIGINAL notarized statement indicating name, date of birth, and place of birth.

- **Photo I.D.** (Parent or Guardian) If an adult other than the parent is registering the child, a copy of the
 - **Guardianship papers** or a sworn affidavit must be presented at registration. This copy will be kept by the
 - school district.

- **Current Custody Papers** (If applicable)

- **Proof of Residency** (Current lease, utility bill, or photo I.D. with correct address.)

- **Immunizations** (It is **Mandatory** that all children starting school have the following immunizations):
 - o *Diphtheria and Tetanus* (4 or more doses of DPT, Td, or DT, or any combination of these with the last dose given after the age of four (4) years.
 - o *Poljomyelitis* (3 doses of oral vaccine or 4 doses of inactivated vaccine).
 - o *Measles, Rubella, and Mumps* (2 doses of measles vaccine preferably given as a second dose of Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR). The Measles, Rubella and Mumps inoculations must be given at age 12 months or older.
 - o *Hepatitis B* vaccine (3 properly spaced doses)
 - o *Chickenpox* vaccine (2 doses as per Dept. of Health requirement) or date of disease

PARENTS MUST BRING THE CHILD’S SHOT RECORD WITH THEM AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION.
