



BIG HORN COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT #3 Annual Public Notice

This annual public notice is being sent out prior to the school year on August 18, 2016.

In accordance with USDE Guidelines IV-O, Title VI: 34 C.F.R. § 100.6 (d) this notice shall serve to advise students, parents, employees and the general public that all Career and Technical Education opportunities of Big Horn County School District #3 shall be offered to all students regardless of race, color, national origin, gender or disability.

During the academic year, Big Horn County School District #3 shall offer the following Career and Technical opportunities as described in the Greybull High School Course Book and make available online at www.greybullschools.com. The admission and criteria for selection in career and technical education programs do not restrict any race, color, sex, national minority origin or students with disabilities from participation in Big Horn County School District #3 career programs.

1. Required to Include a brief summary of program offered- **(See examples below)**
 - **Secondary Subrecipients** - The district programs are offered to all students regardless of race, color, national origin, gender or disability. They are designed to provide students with the necessary knowledge and skills they will need to immediately enter the workforce. Numerous degree and certificate programs prepare students for careers in fields such as health science, STEM, information technology, education, business management and administration, finance, public safety, hospitality, human services, transportation, and manufacturing.
 - **Postsecondary Subrecipients** – The colleges programs of study, both credit and non-credit offered to all students regardless of race, color, national origin, gender or disability. They are designed to provide students with the necessary knowledge and skills they will need to immediately enter the workforce. Numerous degree and certificate programs prepare students for careers in fields such as health science, STEM, IT, business management and administration, finance, public safety, hospitality, human services, transportation, and manufacturing.

2. Required to include a brief summary of admission criteria – **(See example below)**
 - Career and Technical applicants are open to all students regardless of race, color, national origin, gender or disability. Applicants are required to meet the college’s general admission criteria as well as the individual program’s admission criteria. Applicants must contact the program director/coordinator to determine eligibility and qualifications for a specific program. Some programs, such as those in concurrent and dual enrollment, are competitive entry and may require a minimum score on the ACT and or COMPASS tests.

3. The following individuals are designated to coordinate compliance and handle complaints under Title IX and Section 504.
