

## Legacy High School School-wide Homework Policy

Legacy High School's School-wide Homework Policy will align with Clark County School District Regulation 6143. Specifically, "Homework" shall refer to those assignments to be prepared by the student outside of the school or independently outside of the classroom.

### Homework

Homework will be those assignments given to students during the normal course of instruction in all classes regardless of level or subject.

1. Homework assignments will:

- Be assigned as needed by all teachers regardless of subject area.
- Require no more than thirty (30) uninterrupted minutes daily to complete each assignment. Maximum will be 90 minutes per week. (Completion time will vary with student.)
- Be relevant to the course and topic/subject being studied.
- Be used to extend or reinforce classroom learning.
- Be graded, returned, and posted no more than 3 days (meeting) after collection.

*Note:* Honors/AP courses, due to rigorous requirements, will require additional assignments and/or time beyond the homework assigned in non-Honors/AP courses.

2. Unless otherwise indicated, homework will be due during the next meeting of the class.
3. Regularly assigned work will not ordinarily be assigned over holidays or weekends.

*Note:* Honors/AP courses, due to rigorous requirements, will require additional assignments and/or time beyond the assignments/time required in non honors/AP courses.

### Special Projects/Reports

Special projects/reports include but are not limited to research papers, book reports, visual presentations, and oral presentations. These projects will be used to assess student learning beyond the standard test or quiz or to enrich student learning through application.

1. Special projects/reports will:
  - Be periodically assigned.
  - Be assigned in addition to the regularly assigned homework.
  - Be assigned at least two weeks prior to due date.
  - Be graded according to a rubric communicated and discussed with students.
  
2. Special projects will require additional time for grading/assessing by the teacher.
