When someone says or does something UNINTENTIONALLY hurtful and they do it once, that's

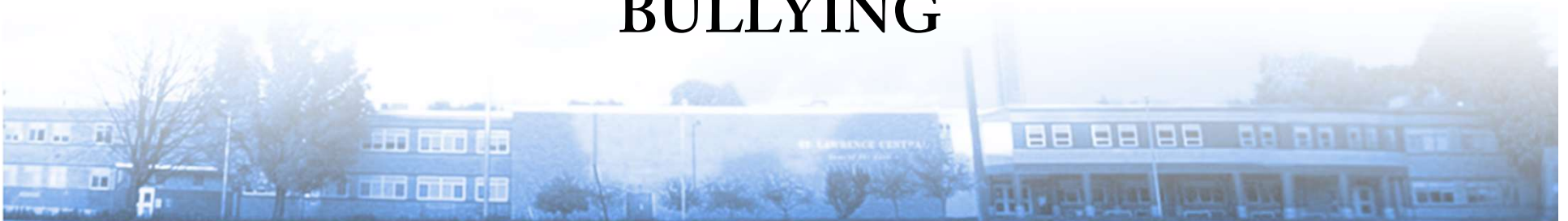
RUDE

OUR THREE PART PLAN

- Prevention
 - “How do we stop bullying before it happens?”
 - Education
 - Pre-intervention wrap around
- Identification
 - “Who can I tell if I am being bullied?”
- Intervention
 - “What will be done to stop the bullying?”



PREVENTION- EDUCATION

- Behavioral training for all students
 - Three school rules of: Be respectful, Be Responsible, and Be Safe
- Second Step character education instruction from our counselor for all students
- Bullying and character education assemblies
 - “Bully Shmully”
 - “Drumming up Your Feelings with Mike Veiny”



PREVENTION- PRE-INTERVENTION WRAP AROUND

- Widespread interventions aimed at reducing bullying instances before they happen
 - I.E. Student seating arrangements on our buses



IDENTIFICATION

- Principal classroom presence each morning
- Principal bus stop presence each afternoon
- “Check and Connect Buddies”
- Digital anonymous bullying reporting form



INTERVENTION

- Student centered conflict resolution
- Student re-teaching
- Student consequences
- Student amelioration through counseling
- Parent notification
- Pre-intervention wrap around
