

Frontier High School Guest Permission Request For All School Dances

Frontier High School is committed to providing a safe environment for students at all times. This includes Frontier dances held on and off campus. Frontier students may request that they be allowed to bring a guest to school dances.

*****Permission to bring a guest is at the discretion of the Dean of Students*****

Guests who are currently enrolled in a high school program or graduated:

1. Must be 20 years of age or younger. Jr. High students are not allowed.
2. Must not be under disciplinary action by any school or district.
3. Must not have any expulsions or Involuntary Transfer on guest's record.
4. Must not have a pending court date or be on formal probation/parole.
5. Must not be on Attendance Step IV / Senior Attendance Policy Level 3 or higher.

*****Frontier administrations will not approve guests outside of these rules and may deny a guest request for any reason.*****

Frontier students wanting to bring a guest must fully complete the reverse side of this page as directed and return it to the Dean's Office.

- All forms turned in prior to the dance will be evaluated and returned to the Frontier student as soon as possible. Forms turned in late may be denied.
- Fill out the form completely before returning it to the Dean's Office.
- Approval may take 24 hours.
- Pick up permission slip from the Dean's office.
- You may then purchase your ticket to the dance at the Finance Office.
- All Frontier students and guests must bring their school ID or a driver's license to every dance.

School dances are school functions, and as such, students are expected to dress and behave in ways that are appropriate for the school setting.

- No inappropriate or suggestive dancing will be allowed
- No simulated sex acts, bending over or grinding
- No dancing that threatens students safety

All students will receive a wristband upon entering the dance. If a student violates the dance policy, the wristband will be removed. If a student violates the dance policy a second time, he/she will be immediately removed from the dance, without refund, and his/her parents will be notified. School personnel will make the final decision concerning appropriate dancing.

If a **Frontier student or guest** is asked to leave or is removed from a dance for any reason, both students may be asked to leave the dance/school site premises. Transportation is not the school's responsibility.

All guests are subject to the same rules and policies as students from the time they arrive to the dance to the time they leave. If a guest is a student at another KHSD school, he/she is also subject to KHSD policies and may be disciplined at his/her home school for wrongful actions at a Frontier dance. **All students and guests will be subject to being searched and/or a breathalyzer test.**
