Dear Parents and Guardians:

We are sending this letter home to inform you about a Stranger Danger incident that occurred outside our main entrance at approximately 7 a.m. this morning, Friday, March 2. Several students reported being beckoned by a lone adult male in a parked, white-colored Audi, who asked for directions. While speaking to the students, the male was observed committing a lewd sexual act. The incident was reported to school officials and the Honolulu Police Department was notified immediately. An investigation is currently underway.

Campus security patrols of the streets and entryways around campus are conducted throughout the day and will be increased following this incident. We ask for your assistance in reporting any suspicious activity you may see around our campus for the safety of our students.

The safety of your children is of utmost importance to us. We are sending this letter to encourage you to continue to speak to your child regarding measures to stay safe, specifically about Stranger Danger. Please reinforce with your child the following safety measures:

- Stay away from strangers. Do not talk to or take anything from them.
- Don't go anywhere with someone you don't know. Never accept a ride from a stranger.
- Stay more than an arm's reach from strangers. If a stranger approaches you, seek help immediately from a trusted adult.
- Use the buddy system. Avoid walking anywhere alone.
- If a stranger grabs you, do whatever it takes to stop the stranger and yell for help.
- Report any suspicious activity to a trusted adult.
- Be alert of your surroundings and let others know where you will be and what time you will be back.
