<i>Application complete and submitted by due date</i>	35pts.
<i>Clearly stated post graduation plans</i>	35pts.
<i>Attendance from previous year</i>	15pts.
<i>Discipline record from previous year</i>	15pts.

*****Attendance rubric: # of full day absences**
0-2 = 15pts, 3-5 = 13pts. 6-8=11 pts
8-10 = 9pts. 11-13 = 7pts. 14-16 =
5pts.
