	<h3>340. RESPONSIBILITY FOR STUDENT WELFARE</h3>
1. Authority SC 510	<p>The Board adopts this policy to ensure appropriate oversight of and responsibility for student welfare by administrative, professional and support employees.</p> <p>District employees are responsible for the safety of students in their charge within school buildings and on district property.</p> <p>Each employee shall maintain a standard of care and concern for supervision, control and protection of students, commensurate with assigned duties and responsibilities.</p> <p>An employee should not voluntarily assume responsibility for duties s/he cannot reasonably perform. Voluntary assumption carries the same responsibilities as assigned duties.</p> <p>Teachers shall provide proper instruction in the safety matters presented in assigned curriculum guides.</p> <p>Each employee has the responsibility to report immediately to the principal an accident or a safety hazard.</p> <p>Employees may not send students on any personal errands.</p> <p>Employees may not transport students in a personal vehicle, except when specifically permitted.</p> <p>Employees shall not require a student to perform work or services that may be detrimental to the student's health.</p>
2. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>Building principals shall monitor employees' adherence to this policy to ensure the maintenance of standards that protect student welfare.</p>
