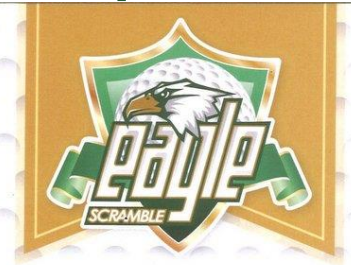
Please welcome our newest faculty member, **Allysha Patrick**. She is our new 5th and 6th grade math teacher and 5th grade science teacher.
