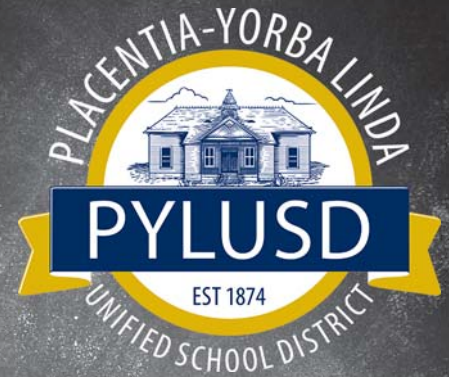


# BOARD HIGHLIGHTS

## Notes from the **Tuesday, Feb. 7, 2017** PYLUSD Board of Education Meeting



### Board Actions

#### 1. Board Policies – adopt, delete, establish and revise

Second readings to revise three Board Policies (BP) and adopt one BP were presented: 0410, "Nondiscrimination in District Programs and Activities"; 4131, "Professional Development for Certificated Staff"; 5137, "Married/Pregnant/Parenting/Lactating Students"; and 6170, "Title I Programs." Additionally, first readings to revise four BPs and establish one BP were presented: 1312.3, "Uniform Complaint Procedure"; 5145.3, "Nondiscrimination/Harassment"; 5145.7, "Sexual Harassment of Students"; 6121, "High School Athletics"; and 6142.7, "Physical Education and Activity." The Board took action to move forward with all BPs.

#### 2. National School Counseling Week

Counselor on Special Assignment (COSA) Kimberly Houg read a Resolution designating Feb. 6 through Feb. 10, 2017, as "National School Counseling Week."

#### 3. College Readiness Block Grant

Deputy Superintendent Candy Plahy presented a proposed three-year plan for the use of the College Readiness Block Grant Funds, and the Board approved it.
