ACTIVITY PARTICIPATION DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING GRADE 6-12 STUDENT AND PARENT INFORMED CONSENT AGREEMENT

As a student and parent/guardian:

- We understand and agree that participation in District extra-curricular and co-curricular programs is a privilege that may be withdrawn for violations of the Drug and Alcohol Testing Policy.
- We have read the Extra-Curricular Substance Abuse Testing Policy and thoroughly understand the responsibilities and consequences as an activity participant in Big Horn County School District #2. *Please see this policy at hs.bgh2.org under the athletics tab/forms.*
- We understand and realize that there is risk of injury in participating in interscholastic programs. We have been provided with and understand information regarding head injuries and concussions and related restrictions on participation in activities.
- We understand participants in District extra-curricular and co-curricular programs will be subject to random and unannounced drug and alcohol testing, and if they refuse, will not be allowed to participate in any District extra-curricular and co-curricular programs until requirements are met to return to activity. We have read the consent statement and agree to its terms.
- We understand if there is reasonable suspicion that an individual participant is using a controlled substance or alcohol the coach/sponsor supervising a District extra-curricular and co-curricular program must report the information to the Building Principal, or designee. If the drug or alcohol test is refused by the activity participant, it will be treated under the policy the same as a positive test.
- We understand this is binding while a student is enrolled in Big Horn County School District #2.
- We consent to Big Horn County School District #2 using foundation money to conduct drug and alcohol testing under this policy.

By signing this agreement, we agree to be bound by all provisions in this policy.
