Professional Experiences:

1974 – 1980 – Assistant Professor in the Department of Political Science at Washington University in St. Louis. He taught undergraduate and graduate courses, and directed research in American politics, public policy analysis, and comparative public policy.

1978 – 1980 – Deputy Assistant Secretary for Planning and Evaluation/Social Services Policy for the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. He directed long-range social services policy planning for children, youth, families, the elderly, Native Americans, and persons with disabilities.

1980 – 1981 – Deputy Director of Policy Development for the Office of Human Development in the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. He directed operational policy development, research, demonstration, and evaluation of human services programs.

1982 – Present – Management and Institutional Development Consulting – The following examples but are a small representation of Dr. McCorry's many professional experiences.

1995 – Haiti. Chief of Party responsible for implementation and budget management of a transitional justice sector modernization program employing a broad range of technical specialists and legal practitioners. Tasks included assuring the provision of effective logistics support and administrative services, contracting and supervision of several construction and renovation projects, and the organization and management of a moderate-sized training institution for the Haitian judiciary.

1998 – Madagascar. Team Leader of a multi-national team conducting an audit of the country's judicial system. The team examined the need for and feasibility of a revised organizational design for the Ministry of Justice and devising a modern mission for that organization.

2001 – 2002 – Ghana. Team Leader of a multidisciplinary team of local consultants that analyzed the human resources management system of the government. The team prepared a proposal for a new management framework for the country's public service.

2002 – Egypt. Evaluation Analyst on a multifaceted final evaluation team assessing the results and impacts of a private sector-led export improvement project based on new agricultural crops.

2003 – Jordan. Evaluation Analyst on a multidisciplinary team that carried out an impact evaluation of a long-term economic growth program. The focal point of this task was to analyze and make recommendations regarding poverty alleviation.

2003 – 2004 – Nigeria. Deputy Team Leader for a multidisciplinary team carrying out a strategic assessment of several development issues in southern Nigeria. Issues covered included Agriculture, Environment Employment, HIV/AIDS, and Conflict Mitigation; and two cross cutting issues: Gender and Urbanization.
