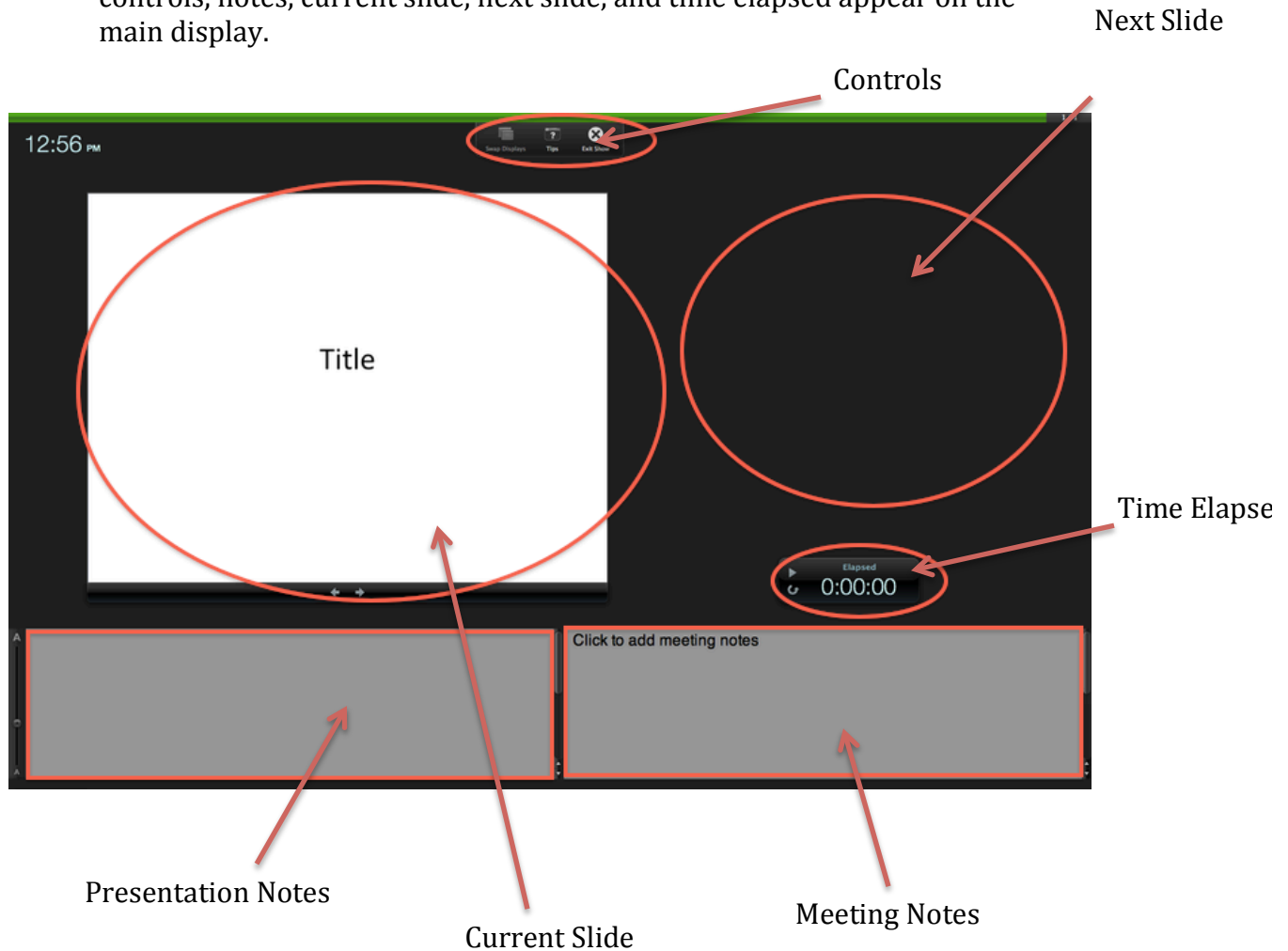
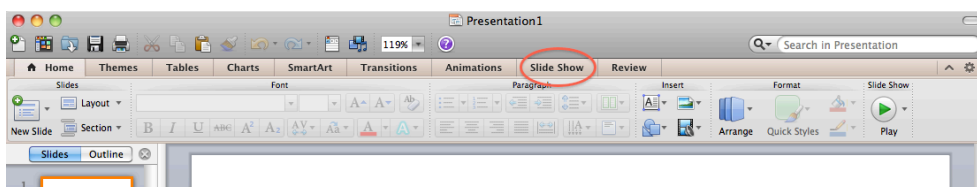


PowerPoint Presenter View:

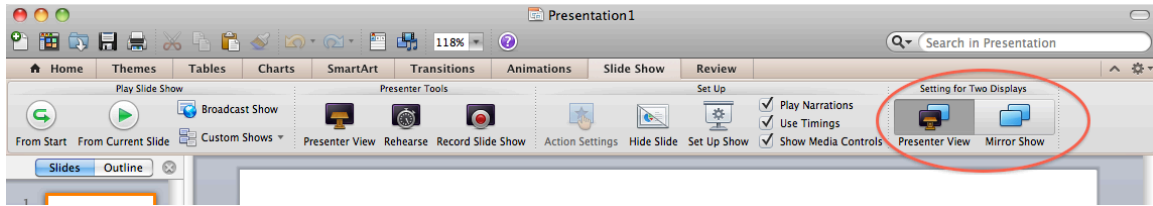
- PowerPoint 2011 defaults to presenter view when a projector is plugged in. This feature allows the actual slide to appear on the SmartBoard, while controls, notes, current slide, next slide, and time elapsed appear on the main display.



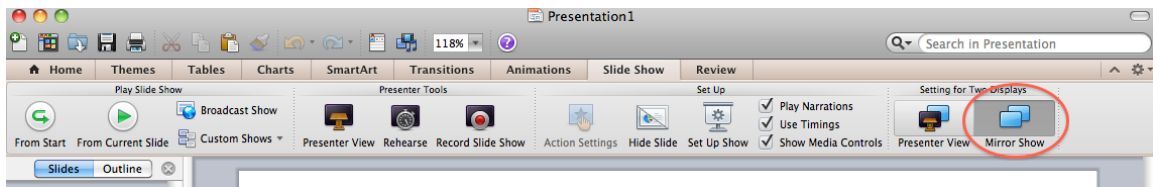
- This is useful for presenting slides; however, it restricts the use of SmartBoard pens to annotate slides and highlight sections.
- In order to interact with the slide using the SmartBoard, "Presenter View" should be switched to "Mirror Show".
- To do so, follow these steps:
 1. Navigate to the "Slide Show" tab of the PowerPoint toolbar.



2. Locate “Setting for Two Display” menu.



3. Choose “Mirror Show”.



“Presenter View” has been switched to “Mirror Show”, which will display the slides on both the main display and projector. The SmartBoard pens and tools can now be used to interact with the presentation.
