

**Goal 1: All students will meet the College/Career Readiness standards in MATH as evidenced by SAT achievement by August 31, 2019**

- 35% of Eleventh grade students will demonstrate proficiency on the scale scores in Mathematics by August 31, 2019 as measured by the SAT.
- 35% of Eleventh grade Female Economically Disadvantaged students will demonstrate a proficiency on the scale scores in Mathematics by August 31, 2019 as measured by the SAT.
- 35% of English Learners students will demonstrate a proficiency on concepts and skills in Mathematics by August 31, 2019 as measured by national, state, and local assessments.

**Goal 2: All students at Watervliet High School will meet College/Career Readiness standards in LITERACY as evidenced by the SAT by August 31, 2019.**

- 35% of Eleventh grade students will demonstrate proficiency on the Reading scale scores in English Language Arts by August 31, 2019 as measured by the SAT.
- 35% of Eleventh grade Female Economically Disadvantaged students will demonstrate proficiency on the Reading scale scores in English Language Arts by August 31, 2019 as measured by the SAT.
- 35% of Eleventh grade students will demonstrate proficiency on the Writing scale scores in English Language Arts by August 31, 2019 as measured by the SAT.
- 35% of Eleventh grade Male Economically Disadvantaged students will demonstrate proficiency on the Writing scale scores in English Language Arts by August 31, 2019 as measured by the SAT.
- 35% of Eleventh grade students will demonstrate proficiency on the Science scale scores by August 31, 2019 as measured by the MME.
- 35% of Eleventh grade students will demonstrate proficiency on the Social Studies scale scores by August 31, 2019 as measured by the MME.
- 35% of Eleventh grade students will demonstrate proficiency in Literacy (for CTE, PE/Health, World Languages, Visual/Performing Arts) in English Language Arts by August 31, 2019 as measured by the SAT.
- 35% of Eleventh grade Female Economically Disadvantaged students will demonstrate proficiency on the Science scale scores by August 31, 2019 as measured by the MME.
- 35% of Eleventh grade Female Economically Disadvantaged students will demonstrate proficiency on the Social Studies scale scores by August 31, 2019 as measured by the MME.
- 35% of English Learners students will demonstrate a proficiency in Reading and Writing in English Language Arts by August 31, 2019 as measured by national, state, and local assessments.
