Arts Pathways Programs

Ladera Vista School of the Arts offers students the opportunity to explore the arts through our many elective classes. Students interested in concentrating their studies in a specific area of the arts have the opportunity to select an Arts-based Pathway. In order to qualify for Pathway Honors, a student must complete at least four of their eight elective choices in a specific arts discipline, achieving a grade of B or higher in each class. An Arts Explorer Pathway is also offered, in which students explore a variety of four Arts-based Electives during the course of their two years at Ladera Vista. Arts Pathways Honors are bestowed on students at the end of their 8th Grade Year.

2017– 2018 Arts Pathways

Choral Arts: Choir I & II and Ladera Vista Performance Classes qualify.

Dance Arts: Students take Dance I & II; Ladera Vista Performance Classes also qualify.

Digital Arts: Students may take Technology I & II, Animation, and LVTV/Yearbook Classes.

Fine Arts: Students may take Art I & II, Advertising Design, and Arts & Crafts.

Instrumental Arts: Guitar, Beginning Band, Intermediate Band, Advanced Band, & Jazz Band.

Theatre Arts: Theatre I & II, LVTV/Yearbook, and Ladera Vista Productions qualify.
