On October 7th, students from Academy of Our Lady participated in a TIC TOC trip to Glassworks in Morristown, NJ to learn about glass fusion art. Glass fusing is a technique used to join glass pieces together to create art. Glass is first fitted together or overlapped to form unique designs and then melted at a high temperature in a kiln. The children learned how to cut glass using a scoring tool with a carbide wheel. Then, working with grozer pliers, they were able to customize glass shapes to use in their unique, one-of-a-kind projects.

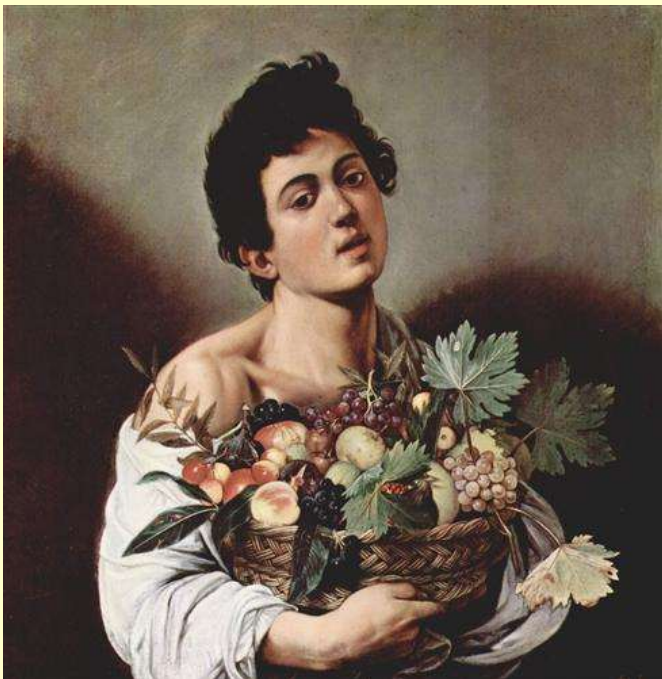

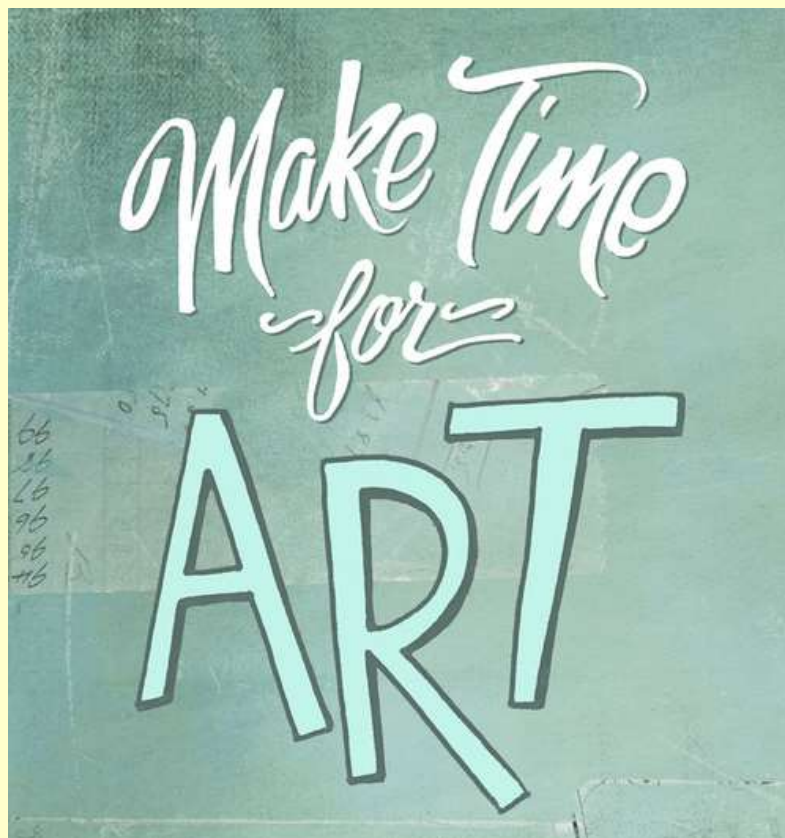
