Overall Rules

1. Students must complete the iNNOLab orientation and pass the orientation test before using the space. Each individual work area and equipment also requires taking a safety class and passing a certification process.
2. Check in with the lab personnel (Collin Turbert, Kara Brown or Eligar Sadeh) when you enter the lab to work.
3. Never use any type of tool for which you have not received training and certification on its proper and safe use even if you have previous experience.
4. Students may use the lab for pre-approved projects only. Any project, competition, class or business that will be performed in the space must first be approved by lab personnel.
5. Lab usage must be scheduled with lab personnel to ensure that there will be no conflicts with other projects.
6. The iNNOLab is to be used for academic purposes only; playing games, socializing, messing around etc. is not allowed and you will be asked to leave.
7. Please consider the safety of all participants while working in the lab. Make sure you are following the safety procedures outlined in the lab safety manual at all time and notify an iNNOLab staff member if you see anyone doing anything you deem unsafe.
8. Report all accidents of any kind to lab personnel.
9. Always clean your work area and put all tools and equipment back into their proper location. Students must begin cleanup 10 minutes prior to the end of their lab time and must check out with lab personnel before leaving the lab.
