Kindergarten Registration Begins

February 20, 2018

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR KINDERGARTEN?

Children who turn five years of age on or before September 1, 2018

WHAT YOU NEED TO ENROLL YOUR CHILD:

1. Birth certificate
2. Proof of residence
3. Physical examination, dated on or after February 20, 2018
4. Immunization record
5. Dental examination

*These immunizations are required:

- Polio (OPV or IPV): 4 doses
✓ (3 doses OK if one was given on or after 4th birthday)
- Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis: 5 doses of DTaP, DTP, or DT
✓ (4 doses OK if one was given on or after 4th birthday)
- Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR or MMRV): 2 doses
✓ (Both given on or after 1st birthday)
- Hepatitis B (Hep B or HBV): 3 doses
- Varicella (chickenpox, VAR, MMRV, or VZV): 1 dose

**Immunization requirements subject to change.*

Please note: Parents must present proof of immunization to school staff prior to admission. Children who have begun any immunization series will be conditionally admitted, provided they are up-to-date and obtain the next dose when due.

Waiver: Per CA State Law SB277 Immunization Law, Personal Belief Exemption (PBE) or Religious Belief Exemption are no longer accepted after January 1, 2016. Please refer to www.shotsforschool.org for further information regarding this new law.

Dental Law AB1433 requires that children enrolled in kindergarten or first grade, whichever is his or her first year in public school, present proof of having received an oral health assessment by a licensed dentist or other licensed or registered dental health professional. (CA. Ed. Code 49492.8 requires that this dental exam take place within 12 months before your child enters school and by May 31 of the school year.)

Kindergarten

- Provides a learning environment that is flexible so that children will find varied opportunities in which they can learn social behaviors that benefit both the individual and the group
- Helps each child develop and maintain a positive self-concept
- Promotes positive interpersonal skills
- Enhances physical skills including small muscle coordination
- Provides a learning program that enables each child to work up to his/her potential
- Assures high levels of success for each child
- Works toward attainment of reading and math readiness skills for each child
