SUBJECT: ADMISSION OF POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS TO BOCES PROGRAMS

In accordance with Section 3202 (as amended) of New York State Education Law, it is the policy of this District that:

- a) A resident veteran of any age who shall have served as a member of the armed forces of the United States and who shall have been discharged therefrom under conditions other than dishonorable, shall be permitted to attend programs of the Board of Cooperative Educational Services, and tuition costs for such attendance will be borne by the District. Transportation shall be the responsibility of the veteran student.
- b) A resident non-veteran student under twenty-one years of age who has received a high school diploma shall be permitted to attend school or programs at the Board of Cooperative Educational Services, provided that there is available space in the programs requested, and such students shall be responsible for payment of full tuition charges to the Massena Central School District prior to beginning of the class, and for his/her own transportation. The student shall be required to present:
 - proof of age - examples of acceptable forms of documentation include, but are not limited to, a birth certificate, baptismal record, an entry in a family bible, an adoption record, an affidavit from a parent/guardian, or a passport (including a foreign passport);
 - record of immunizations and a health certificate from a licensed physician; and
 - proof of district residency - examples of acceptable forms of documentation include, but are not limited to, a pay stub, income tax form, mortgage or lease documents to a house or apartment, telephone or utility bills or other bills sent to the student's home address, rent payment receipts, a copy of a money order for payment of rent, a letter from a parent's employer that is written on company letterhead, voter registration document or a state- or other government-issued ID.
