BASS Reminders

If a child attends BASS more than six times in one month, the monthly rate will be charged. A bill for the monthly rate or drop-in charges will be sent to you at the end of each month. The drop-in charge will be posted on the last day of the month, regardless of which days your child attended BASS.

Forgetting to sign your child out with the time will result in a charge until 6:00 pm on that day.

There are several months where, because of school vacations, BASS will be closed for a significant part of the month; therefore the monthly rate will be pro-rated as follows:

- December- 75 % of the regular monthly rate
- Easter Break month-75 % of the monthly rate
- June- 50 % of the monthly rate



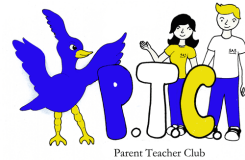
