The counseling department would like to share the following scholarship information:

The **1000th Man Scholarship**, sponsored by 211 Enterprises and awarded by the Saugus High School club "Not One More" teen suicide. To apply, students must be a senior and have attended Saugus High School for two years. Applicants must have a GPA of 2.0, and write an essay on the prompt which is listed on the application. To apply, please pick up an application in the counseling office, or download the attachment on this message. Applications are due by March 23, 2018.

The **Santa Clarita Valley Education Foundation** sponsors a scholarship for local high school seniors who have demonstrated an interest in pursuing a career related to education. Last year, the foundation awarded multiple scholarships to students graduating from local high schools. Applicants must have a GPA of at least 2.5 to apply and must be attending college in the 2018-19 school year as a full-time student pursuing a degree in a field related to a career in education.
