

THE COLONEL HARRY L. DALE SCHOLARSHIP

The Colonel Harry L. Dale Scholarship is an endowed scholarship fund at the University of Oregon. The purpose of the fund is to provide the award to an outstanding graduating Baker High School senior who has been admitted to, and plans to attend, the **University of Oregon**. The tuition award is renewable for three additional academic years, providing the recipient meets the minimum university academic requirements for renewal.

BACKGROUND: Colonel Dale was born and raised in Baker City, Oregon. He graduated from Baker High School in the Class of 1902. In 1906, he graduated from the University of Oregon. He completed his medical education at Harvard and Rush Medical Schools. Upon graduation, he pursued a medical career in the U.S. Army, retiring from active duty in 1946.

CRITERIA: The recipient shall be selected on the basis of financial need, academic ability, personal integrity, and potential value as a citizen, leadership, and character. **Student must also have applied for FAFSA.**

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE APPLICANT:

1. Complete the required information on the attached application form.
2. On a separate sheet, please provide your high school resume. This should include your major high school/community activities, volunteer service, and work experiences. Indicate any leadership positions and/or special honors/awards. Please also include beginning and ending dates.
3. Complete and attach a short essay (no more than one page) describing yourself. Please comment on your goals and aspirations, what you hope to achieve in life, and how you feel about yourself as a person. Your comments should give a more complete picture of you.
4. Complete and attach a short essay (no more than one page) stating your views of what you consider your citizenship responsibilities in the family, the community, and the nation.
5. Complete and attach a short essay (no more than one page) describing your most significant accomplishment and explain why you believe it to be your most outstanding.
6. A high school transcript will need to be attached to your completed application.
7. Since your application must be reviewed by the Scholarship Selection Committee in written form, completeness of the application, and the care with which it is prepared will obviously influence the Committee's judgement. The procedures and questions should be self-explanatory. If in doubt, please consult your high school counselor.
8. Your completed application form and attachments must be returned to the Baker High School Guidance Center by **MARCH 1st**.
