

Community Relations

SOLICITATION OF FUNDS FROM AND BY STUDENTS

All selling or soliciting activities must be approved at least 15 days before the activity. If the event involves a contract with a commercial vendor, the contract shall be reviewed by the Superintendent or designee.

In order to minimize interruptions to regularly scheduled instruction, staff shall limit fundraising activities to appropriate time periods designated by the principal.

(cf. 6116 Classroom interruptions)

The principal or designee shall ensure that letters are sent to parents/guardians regarding all fund-raising activities. Signed parent permission is required for a student to participate in the fund-raising activity.

No more than five (5) fundraisers shall be held at any school site during any one school year.

All fundraising activities must be concluded within the duration of 10 school days unless special provisions are made with the Superintendent or designee.

No student shall be required to raise a specified amount of money in order to participate in an instructional or co-curricular related activity.

Students making solicitations on behalf of the school or for school related projects are expected to be courteous and respectful towards all individuals and businesses, whatever the outcome of the solicitation may be.

Door to Door Sales

The District encourages students to sell items only to people that they know. Students are not to sell door to door.
