

PowerSchool Access Information

Parents and students of Bordentown Regional High School are able to view student schedules, grades and attendance through PowerSchool, the District's student information system. PowerSchool is used to schedule, take attendance, store grades, produce transcripts, report cards, and more. Instructions for parent/student access to PowerSchool are located on the Bordentown Regional High School Website.

PowerSchool has developed an "(app)lication" for iPads, iPhones and androids so Student and Parents can login from those devices. In order for the application to work, parents must reset their parent portal username and password and link it to their child. This must be done by going to the PowerSchool Parent Portal and press Create Account before logging in.
