



PreAP/AP/DUAL Summer Reading

CISD requires students who are enrolled in PreAP/AP/DUAL English to read over the summer. Reading over the summer allows teachers to begin literacy discussions at the level of depth and complexity required in an Advanced Academic course during the first few weeks of school. Reading over the summer also helps students maintain English Language Arts skills. It exposes students to quality literature that they may not pick up on their own and promotes independent reading, inquiry, and scholarship which will facilitate students as lifelong learners.

- **English I Pre-AP**
 - Students entering English I Pre-AP will read one required book:
 - *The Pearl* by John Steinbeck
- **English II Pre-AP**
 - Students entering EII Pre-AP will read one required book:
 - *To Kill a Mockingbird* Harper Lee
- **English III AP/DUAL**
 - Students entering EIII AP or DUAL will read one required book:
 - **AP-** *They Say/I Say: The Moves That Matter in Academic Writing* by Gerald Graff and Cathy Birkenstein
 - **DUAL-** *They Say/I Say: The Moves That Matter in Academic Writing* by Gerald Graff and Cathy Birkenstein
- **English IV AP/DUAL**
 - Students entering EIV AP or DUAL will read one required book, completing an analytical reading journal*:
 - **AP-** *How to Read Literature Like a Professor* by Thomas C. Foster
 - **DUAL-** *How to Read Literature Like a Professor* by Thomas C. Foster
