


## Concurrent Enrollment

PLTW Principles of Engineering is a concurrent enrollment class offered through Utah State University (USU). It is required that the students enroll at USU, register for the class, and pay the associated fees in order to remain in the engineering program at the JATC.

### Step 1: Go to **concurrent.usu.edu**

**Step 2:** Apply to USU to receive a USU "A Number" (student number). This step has a \$50 admission fee that can be paid online.

**Step 3:** Register for ENGR 1000. To do this you will select the student's **home high school** and then select ENGR 1000, CRN 55462, with Noelle Schick. There is no option to select the JATC as your high school, the course can only be found under the student's home high school. The class registration opens on **August 21, 2017**.

**Step 4:** Pay the associated fees for USU for the concurrent enrollment course. There is a \$5 fee per credit with ENGR 1000 being a 2.0 credit course the total will be \$10.
