## **SUBJECT: BOARD OF EDUCATION MEMBERS: QUALIFICATIONS**

A Board of Education member of the Massena Central School District must meet the following qualifications:

- a) A citizen of the United States;
- b) Eighteen (18) years of age;
- c) Able to read and write;
- d) Not adjudged to be an incompetent by a court;

*(Note: a convicted felon is barred from running for a seat on a board of education if his or her maximum prison sentence has not expired or if he or she has not been pardoned or discharged from parole)*

- e) A legal resident one (1) year prior to the election;
- f) Cannot be an employee of the Massena Central School District;
- g) The only member of his/her family (that is, cannot be a member of the same household) on the school-Massena Central School District Board;
- h) May not simultaneously hold another, incompatible public office;
- i) Must not have been removed from a school district office within one year preceding the date of election to the Board.

The Board may reject nominations if the candidate is ineligible or has declared unwillingness to serve.
