ELEMENTARY MUSIC INSTRUCTION

The Block Music Program offers music education to every student in grades 4-6. Once a week for 45 minutes, these students will be enrolled in either vocal/general or instrumental music, not missing any regular class instruction. Instrumental students will have one additional lesson each week. **Students will participate in their chosen class for the entire school year.**

As instrumental classes are often large, students selecting this class should be able to work independently and be able to work in an environment that is highly stimulating and filled with sound.

**PARENT INFORMATION MEETING
FOR BEGINNING BAND AND BEGINNING STRINGS**

There will be a district wide instrumental music meeting night for parents of beginning students on Monday, September 11, 2017 @ the district **Professional Development Academy** located at 4999 Casa Loma Ave., Yorba Linda (corner of Yorba Linda Boulevard and Casa Loma Avenue.) The meeting will begin at 7pm and is recommended, but not required. Instrumental music teachers will greet you and explain the program. Several area retailers will have display tables where you may inspect instruments, obtain rental information, etc. These displays will be open at 6:30 p.m. The school district has a limited number of instruments available for those students who are unable to obtain their own due to financial need.

CLASS CHOICES

4TH Grade: Choose **one** of the following classes:

- **Vocal/General Music** – (Class meets **once** a week)
 1. Students are introduced to music through singing, use of rhythm instruments and music appreciation.
 2. This is not a performance class.
- **Beginning Strings** – (Class meets **twice** a week)
 1. Students learn to play one of the string instruments from the orchestra (violin, viola, cello or bass).
 2. Parents are advised that students are responsible to bring their instrument/materials to and from school each lesson.
 3. **This is a performance class requiring home practice and at least one evening concert.**

5th Grade: Choose **one** of the following classes:

- **Vocal/General Music** – (Class meets **once** a week)
 1. Students study music through singing, rhythm instruments and music appreciation.
 2. This is not a performance class.
- **Intermediate Strings** – (Class meets **twice** a week)
 1. Students must have at least 1-year experience on a string instrument.
 2. Parents are advised that students are responsible to bring their instrument/materials to and from school each lesson.
 3. **This is a performance class requiring home practice and at least one evening concert.**
- **Beginning Band** – (Class meets **twice** a week)
 1. Students learn to play one of the band instruments from the band (flute, clarinet, saxophone, trombone, baritone, trumpet or percussion).
 2. Parents are advised that students are responsible to bring instrument and materials to and from school each lesson.
 3. **This is a performance class requiring home practice and at least one evening concert.**

6th Grade: Choose **one** of the following classes:

****STUDENTS MAY NOT START A NEW INSTRUMENT IN 6TH GRADE****

- **Vocal/General Music** – (Class meets **once** a week)
 1. Students study music through singing, rhythm instruments and music appreciation.
 2. This is not a performance class.
- **Adv. Band or Adv. Strings** – (Class meets **twice** a week)
 1. Students must have at least 1-year experience on a band instrument or 2-years experience on a string instrument.
 2. Parents are advised that students are responsible to bring their instrument/materials to and from school each lesson.
 3. **These are performance classes requiring home practice and two evening concerts.**

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC EQUIPMENT LIST

Beginning Strings (String Bass, Cello, Viola, and Violin)
All students purchase a 1/2" loose-leaf binder for music class.

Books: All For Strings, Book 1
 Please Note: String instruments come in different sizes (1/4, 1/2, 3/4, 4/4) enabling them to be played by any size student.

Equipment: Instrument, case, bow, rosin - provide a soft cloth to clean rosin from instrument; shoulder pad will be provided by the district.

Viola Students: If you cannot rent a viola your size, rent the correct size violin and request the music store to convert it to a viola.

Beginning Band Woodwinds (Flute, Clarinet, and Saxophone)
All students purchase a 1/2" loose-leaf binder for music class.

Books: Accent on Achievement, Book 1
 Flute: Instrument, case, cleaning rod; provide a 10" square of thin, soft cloth like a handkerchief

Clarinet: Instrument, case, cleaning swab, cork grease; you will need at least three size #2-1/2 reeds to start.

Saxophone: Same as clarinet, plus neckstrap.

Beginning Band Brass (Trombone, Baritone, and Trumpet)
All students purchase a 1/2" loose-leaf binder for music class.

Books: Accent on Achievement, Book 1
 Trumpet: Instrument, case, valve oil, tuning slide grease

Trombone: Instrument, case, slide cream/small spray bottle or slide oil, tuning slide grease

Baritone: Instrument, case, valve oil, tuning slide grease

Beginning Band Percussion (Drums & Bells)
All students purchase a 1/2" loose-leaf binder for music class.

Books: Accent on Achievement, Book 1- Combined Percussion

Percussion Kit: Includes drum pad and stand, sticks, bells

Please Note: Previous experience on another instrument is recommended and **limited enrollment will be determined by the instructor** based on an interview/audition. For this reason, please indicate a **2nd choice** of instrument on the enrollment form.
