

Transportation Director Action:

If a student is not properly observing bus rider safety regulation, the Director of Transportation (subject to the degree of the offense) may initiate the following steps:

1st Notice – Warning; student conference; parent notification.

2nd Notice – Parent/Student conference with campus administrator; student subject to 3-5 school days' suspension of bus privileges.

3rd Notice – Student is subject to up to ten (10) school days' suspension of bus privileges.

4th Notice – Student denied riding privileges for the remainder of the semester, the remainder of the school year, or possibly permanent removal of bus privileges.

Further Offenses – Student denied riding privileges for the remainder of the year with parent and school notification.

Severe Clause:

Those offenses that can be classified as severe and disruptive in nature (E.G., fighting, serious insubordination/disrespect or endangerment) will result in immediate referral to the student's campus administrator, and may lead to immediate and/or long term suspension from the school bus and could also result in the student receiving a citation by local law enforcement authorities.
