Our students did well. ○ LA: All teachers trained this summer in OG phonics strategies to help all struggling learners. ○ Math continuing thinking sheets, MP3 (reasoning), ○ Teachers have time to talk to each other. This past week teachers met K-2 to have cross grade level articulation. ○ Waiau’s high needs students do not fare as well as our general population so our gap numbers are a focus for us. We would like to see it lower again. ○ Mr. Takazono shared the KA‘EO assessment scores ● Academic Plan <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ In January we will look at the implications of the Strive HI data on whether we need to adjust our academic plan ○ New Superintendent focus: school design, collaboration, and student voice. ● WASC mid cycle report will be submitted in spring 2019. Kumu Makanoë to start working with all role groups to collect data and draft this spring. ● AC: state level people have been helping us prepare the scope of the work so that we can get the project done in F building. ● Parents asked about the courtyard project.
