

COMMUNITY SERVICE – VOLUNTEERISM

At graduation, we acknowledge seniors who perform at least 18 hours of community service.

We keep the recognition simple in our commencement program with a superscript [✎] notation next to graduates' names.

MHS does not mandate community service as that seems contradictory to the spirit of volunteerism.

We examined various models that other schools have used. It can be onerous authenticating hours of service so we **keep the process simple**. **For recognition, students must, by June 1, hand in 3 x 5 file card(s) to the Main Office with the following information:**

PLEASE:

- PRINT the information on 5 separate lines of the file card.
- *Do not hand in community service in excess of 18 hours - we will not record it!*

Volunteerism for (almost) any cause/person/group is acceptable.

*However, the hours should be outside of the school day to count!
