SUBJECT: NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

Non-resident families who wish to enroll children in the School System shall submit a request in writing to the Superintendent, who shall determine whether or not the student(s) will be admitted. The Superintendent will also determine which building the student will attend.

The authority to refuse entrance to non-resident students, however, is retained by the Massena Board of Education. Such refusal may be based on class size, disciplinary record of student, and/or factors leading the Board of Education to believe that the student's acceptance into the Massena Central School District would not be in the student's or the District's best interest.

Non-resident families must provide their own transportation.

Tuition will be charged to families of non-resident students. The amount of tuition shall be determined by the Board.

The Board of Education will approve the tuition rate at its Reorganizational Meeting in July each year. The tuition rate will be based on the most current Actual Non-Resident Tuition Report generated by the State Education Department, and which is based upon costs per student to the District of the previous fiscal year.
