GENERAL INFORMATION

Rutherford County middle school athletics will adhere to rules and regulations set forth by the TMSAA and the The Rutherford County Athletic Handbook unless otherwise stated in the Rutherford County Middle School Athletic Guidelines.

Athletic Advisory Committee – Will Shelton, Fred Barlow, Kim Stoecker

All Cheerleader coaches shall be ACCAA certified.

Beginning with the 2015-2016 school year, the District Athletic Director will develop schedules for each sport in the tournament rotation. These will be known as the “official schedules”. All conference tournament and championship seeding will be based on standings from the official schedules. When scheduling athletic games, no games shall be scheduled on designated Parent/Teacher dates.

The District Athletic Director will serve as the purchasing agent for all trophies that are awarded by the conference or for tournaments. Each middle school will be billed for their share of the trophies at the end of each tournament season.

The regular season Conference Champion for baseball, basketball, football, soccer, softball, and volleyball will be recognized, awarded a trophy, and will be responsible for the cost of the trophy.

A regular season All-Conference team for baseball, basketball, football, soccer, softball, and volleyball will be selected based on the performance of individual athlete’s during the regular season. Each school will select their recipient(s) for this award except basketball. The Basketball All-Conference team is selected by WGNS. Each school will be responsible for the costs of the All-Conference trophies that they earned.

Rutherford County Middle Schools will rotate hosting conference championship games or conference tournaments based on the athletic tournament schedule. A school designee from all tournament host schools, including JVs, shall contact the RCS Athletics Director well in advance to discuss tournament procedures (Tournament Hosting Checklist is found on p.21 of this document). Only recognized and approved school teams with an approved school coach, may participate in county athletic contests and/or tournament championships. Tournament hosts are responsible for all tournament costs including the Champion, Runner-up, and All-Tournament Team trophies.

The championship/tournament rotation is found on p. 3.

Unless otherwise noted, seeding for tournaments will be based on conference records. In cases where two or more schools end the season with tying records, the tie will be broken and number one seed will be determined as

1. Head to Head
2. How you did vs. common opponent top of standings to bottom until tie is broken
3. Draw numbers for tie breakers on a tournament by tournament basis. Lowest seed in question will go to the team with the lowest number. These numbers will be drawn in early April at an announced place, date, and time by the RC AD.

Tournament brackets from printyourbrackets.com shall be used.

It is at the discretion of each school to determine if they will charge admission for regular season games. All sports that choose to charge admission for a regular season game will have an admission price of \$5.00. Schools participating in scrimmages/exhibition games must agree if admission is to be charged. Coaches for each sport must communicate to the other coaches that they will be charging an admission. Coaches are responsible for informing parents of these admission guidelines. Sports pricing guidelines are the same for varsity or junior varsity contests. School-age students, kindergarten and up, will be charged full admission price. County employees are admitted free with their ID badge. This free admission is for the county employee only.

The host school of the tournament must decide if they are going to charge a tournament fee or admission; the host school cannot charge both a fee and gate admission. The admission for tournaments will be the same price as the regular season admission.

Schools must go through the local TSSAA approved association to get their officials. All officials (referees and umpires) must be TSSAA certified. Junior varsity officials are not required to be TSSAA certified

Host schools who are holding special events such as Homecoming, 8th Grade Recognition Night, etc, that might impact normal game activities or length are to communicate that information to the visiting schools, in advance.

Jamborees, scrimmages, and junior varsity games will be played at the discretion of individual schools. These contests have no bearing on regular season conference standings or championships.

Athletic contests will be cancelled when school is cancelled due to weather. Athletic events may be played when school has been cancelled only when the Director of Schools authorizes athletic events to continue and the principals of both schools agree to play.

Every coach is responsible for ensuring good sportsmanship and is expected to abide by the Coaches Code of Ethics. Running the score up on an opponent is unacceptable. Concerns regarding a school running up the score on an opponent should be directed to the school principals.

*There shall be a First Practice Date for each Sports Season. The First Practice Date for the Fall Season is Monday, the week of August 1. The First Practice Date for the Winter Season is Monday, the week of October 1. The First Practice Date for the Spring Season is Monday, the week of February 1. The Local Education Association will determine in which season each sport is played.

BASEBALL

All Rutherford County middle schools are required to play each other one time. The results of those games will count toward each school's conference record. Those specific conference dates will be designated on the official schedule. Additional games or tournaments may be scheduled by individual school coaches but will not count toward conference standings. All conference games are to be played and have priority over non-conference games.

Number of Regular Season Contests – 18 games

Official game scores/standings contact –

Admission Price – The admission price for schools that choose to charge admission is \$5.00 for everyone in kindergarten and older. Children not yet in kindergarten are admitted free of charge.

Starting Times – Starting times for games before the daylight savings time change will be at 4:00 p.m. Starting game times after the time change will be 4:30.

Pitcher/Catcher Start Date – Pitchers and catchers may start January 1st.

Practice Start Date – The first practice date is Monday, the week of February 1.

Start Date for Games – Non-League games 2nd Monday in March. League games will begin on Thurs of that week.

Off Season Practice – None

Summer Practice – No Restrictions except the Dead Period. (The week preceding the 4th of July week and the week of the 4th of July.)

Rainouts or Darkness – In cases of rainouts or darkness, the host school will reschedule the game on the first date available for both teams. Failure of the host school to reschedule the game on the first available date will result in the game being counted as a loss for the host school. Any questions pertaining to a game-date conflict will be resolved by the principals of the schools. All games must be made up and any games that are not made up will count as a loss.

If a game is called due to darkness before the fifth inning, then the game is not official and must be completed on the first available date. If a game called because of darkness after 5th inning is complete, the game is official. If a game is called after the first half of an inning, the score reverts back to the last complete inning and the rest of the game must be rescheduled.

Pitching Rule – The Junior Division baseball pitching rule provides: “A pitcher may pitch no more than twelve innings in any one calendar week (Sunday through Saturday) and no more than seven innings in any one day. After pitching four or more innings in any one game, the pitcher must have at least two days rest before he or she can pitch again. (For example, if a pitcher pitches four or more innings any time on Monday, that pitcher would not be able to pitch again until Thursday, etc. If a pitcher pitches to any batter, the pitcher is charged with an inning.) If removed as a pitcher, the player may play any other position.”- TSSAA Handbook

Conference Championship/Tournament – All-Conference and All-Tournament trophies will be awarded using the following formula:

1st place – 3 members

2nd place – 2 members

All remaining teams will have 1 member.

Guidelines for the tournament are as follows:

Double Elimination format shall be used

Gate fees will be \$5.00 dollars

Outside coolers will not be allowed in the seating area. Each dugout will have water coolers.

No pre-game batting practice in the hitting cage.

No pre-game infield practice at this time. This could change depending on the tournament schedule.

In the event of darkness or rain, tournament games to be completed except when the 10 run rule is in effect.

All Rutherford County middle schools are required to play each other one time. The results of those games will count toward each school's conference record. Those specific conference dates will be designated on the official schedule. Additional games or tournaments may be scheduled by individual school coaches but will not count toward conference standings. All conference games are to be played and have priority over non-conference games.

Number of Regular Season Contests – 18 games plus season ending tournament. Tournaments count as two games notwithstanding the number of games in which each team participates in a tournament.

Official game scores/standings contact –

Admission Price – The admission price for schools that choose to charge admission is \$5.00 for everyone in kindergarten and older. Children not yet in kindergarten are admitted free of charge.

Starting Times – All games will begin at 6:00 and will be played on Monday or Thursday nights unless both schools agree to an alternative date or time.

Practice Start Date – The first practice date is Monday, the week of October 1.

Start Date for Games – Oct. 12, 2015 for the '15-'16 season. (No regular season games will be scheduled prior to the 2nd Monday after the first practice date.)

Off Season Practice – Off season practice will consist of no more than 10 days within 15 consecutive school days and 2 interschool scrimmages.

Summer Practice – No Restrictions except the Dead Period. (The week preceding the 4th of July week and the week of the 4th of July.)

Conditioning – There shall be no team specific conditioning in the fall prior to the start date of practice.

Open Gym – Once school starts in the fall, coaches may only have school wide open gyms that are announced during school hours for all students.

Conference Championship/Tournament – All-Conference and All-Tournament trophies will be awarded using the following formula:

1st place – 3 members

2nd place – 2 members

All remaining teams will have 1 member.

FOOTBALL

Rutherford County middle schools will play the other middle schools one time with the exception of one school. The schedule will be rotated every other year so that the school not included in the schedule in the two year rotation will be included in the next rotation. The two teams with the best record will play each other in the championship game.

Number of Regular Season Contests – 8 games.

Official game scores/standings contact –

Admission Price – The admission price for schools that choose to charge admission is \$5.00 for everyone in kindergarten and older. Children not yet in kindergarten are admitted free of charge.

Starting Times – All game times will be determined by the host school with ample notification and will be played on Tuesday nights unless both schools agree to an alternative date or time.

JV Games – played before or after varsity games on Tuesdays.

Fall Practice Start Date – Determined by TMSAA.

Start Dates for Games – See the official schedule.

Off Season Practice – Off season practice will consist of no more than 10 days within 15 consecutive school days and 2 interschool scrimmages.

Summer Practice – No pads, Dead Period. (The week preceding the 4th of July week and the week of the 4th of July.)

Game Tapes – Game tapes of the previous two games shall be exchanged.

Conference Championship – All-Conference trophies will be given by the following formula:

- 1st place/Champion – 4 members
- 2nd place/Runner-up – 3 members
- All remaining teams will have 1 member.

The two teams with the best record will be considered the number one and number two seed for the championship game. In cases where two or more schools end the season with tying records, the tie will be broken as follows:

1. Head to Head competition
2. Total conference victories
3. Draw numbers for multiple tie breakers. Lowest seed in question will go to the team with the lowest number. These numbers will be drawn in early April at an announced place, date, and time by the RC AD.

The championship game will be played the Saturday following the completion of the season or another time agreed to by both teams involved and the host school. The home team will be determined by which team hosts the championship game.

Number of Regular Season Contests – 12 matches.

Official game scores/standings contact –

Admission Price – The admission price for schools that choose to charge admission is \$5.00 for everyone in kindergarten and older. Children not yet in kindergarten are admitted free of charge.

Starting Times – No earlier than 4:00 on school days.

Spring Practice Start Date (Boys) – The first practice date is Monday, the week of February 1.

Fall Practice Start Date (Girls) – The first practice date is Monday, the week of August 1.

Start Date for Games – See the official schedule. (One week later in the fall than last year.)

Off Season Practice – None

Summer Practice – No Restrictions except the Dead Period. (The week preceding the 4th of July week and the week of the 4th of July.)

Conference Championship/Tournament – All-Conference and All-Tournament trophies will be awarded using the following formula:

1st place – 3 members

2nd place – 2 members

All remaining teams will have 1 member.

Tournament seeding will be based on a team's total points earned from conference games on the official schedule. Points are awarded to a team using the following formula:

3 points for a win

1 point for a tie

0 points for a loss.

If a game is called due to darkness before the fifth inning, then the game is not official and must be completed on the next available date. If a game called because of darkness after 5th inning is complete, the game is official. If a game is called after the first half of an inning, the score reverts back to the last complete inning and the rest of the game must be rescheduled. The first available date will be the first day neither team has a scheduled game or school conflict and the home field is playable.

Conference Championship/Tournament – All-Conference and All-Tournament trophies will be awarded using the following formula:

GOLF

Rutherford County Middle Schools offer boys and girls the opportunity to play for their school golf team. Coaches hold tryouts either in the fall or early spring. All medical and personal information forms must be filled out completely before tryouts. This includes forms required by both the TSSAA and the TMSGGA. Yearly cost for each player usually runs around \$200 per student and includes greens fees, uniforms, and dues. All team members will be given the opportunity to fund raise their fees. Coaches also hold a meeting (usually over dinner) and schedule all their matches at one time, all together. This meeting is planned and led by the Rutherford County Middle School Golf Commissioner, and is usually held in January. Each school that wishes to host matches must communicate with their “home” golf course that they will use for practices and matches during the season prior to the scheduling meeting to secure dates for matches. Some teams will use the same course, so communication with the golf course (and the other coach) is crucial. Some courses will set a price for the individuals on each team to pay, which allows them access to range balls and practice areas, as well as covering green fees for the athlete to walk and play the course for the duration of the season. Other courses charge “as you go,” not allowing a flat rate fee for the season. Local courses used are Champions Run, Cedar Crest, Bloomfield Links, Indian Hills, the V.A., and Smyrna Executive golf course.

All teams wishing to participate in the district tournament must join the Tennessee Middle School Golf Association (TMSGGA). Hayden Echols is the director of the TMSGGA. His office number is 615-465-6327. All of the required forms for the TMSGGA can be found at their website, <http://www.tnuniorgolf.com/Home-106.html>. The official start date of the golf season is usually early February, but due to weather and sunlight constraints, practices usually start in early March (post daylight savings time change) and matches beginning in late March. The pre-season jamboree is held in early March as a kickoff to the season. The season ends with the county championship held the first part of May, followed by the District and Regional tournaments the weeks after. In between these two tournaments, matches are played. Matches are normally dual or tri matches, contested over 9 holes. A minimum of 5 holes are required (prior to the district tournament) for the match to be official. Golfers are paired at the beginning of the match and keep the scorecard of their opponents. At the conclusion of the match, players return scorecards, confirm scores, and sign cards. The coaches for each team will calculate the score of all varsity golfers (determined before the start of the match) and post the team totals, with lowest combined score winning (four scores for boys and two scores for girls). There is always a maximum score of triple-bogey for all players (even during the post-season).

The post-season begins with the Rutherford County Middle school Championship hosted by Cedar Crest Golf Course, usually in early May. After the county tournament, the district tournament is a one-day event with boys playing 18 holes and girls playing 9 holes. All school teams that join the Tennessee Middle School Golf Association (TMSGGA) and that participate in at least 5 matches against fellow TMSGGA member schools will play in the district tournament. Depending on the number of member teams in the district, a limited number of schools and individuals will advance to play in the region tournament. All players play 2 days at the region tournament, with both days being 18 holes. The region tournament consists of schools and individuals from all over the mid-state. Both the district and the region tournament are planned and conducted by the TMSGGA.

CROSS COUNTRY

Conditioning begins the second week of July. Tryouts typically take place the first or second week of school. Races are 1.5-2 miles in length, normally held on Saturday mornings, and include JV and Varsity races. The season ends in October. Each coach is responsible for scheduling their meets for the season. Coaches use the Mid-State Cross Country Association website or the Tennessee Runner website to identify meets to compete in. Registration for these meets is usually completed online by accessing the links supplied by the above mentioned websites. The county championship is scheduled during the beginning of the season by way of coach’s consensus on date and time. The mid-state cross country championship is usually held in Macon County and is a qualifying meet for the Middle School State Cross Country meet in Knoxville, TN.

TRACK

Conditioning for track season begins after students return from fall break with tryouts typically held in February. The first meets of the season begin in March and last through April. Athletes compete in the following events during meets: 100m, 4x100m, 200m, 4x200m, 400m, 4x400m, 800m, 4x800m, 1600m, 100m hurdles, long jump, high jump, shot put, and discuss. Race directors may set regulations on how many varsity runners from each team can compete in each event, as well as, determine order of events, JV races, and the inclusion/exclusion of certain events. Coaches from each team are used to help score and time events during a meet. The coaches in the county will meet and set the date and time for the county championships, which typically allow for a girls championship and boys championship to be ran on separate days.

BOWLING

Beginning in the fall of each year, the Smyrna Bowling Center encourages students from participating middle schools to meet from 3:00 PM to 5:00 PM and form bowling clubs. These kids are able to participate in club bowling at the rate of two games plus shoes for \$5.00. The season will begin in January, with matches and practices normally held at Lane, Trains, and Automobiles or Smyrna Bowling Center. During the season, bowlers pay a set practice fee per bowler that will allow the lane access and shoes, and matches during the season are free. The season runs through March, ending in playoffs between teams to name individual and team champions.
