

## SRVHS Wi-Fi Certificate update

Our Wi-Fi security settings will be updated on December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015. This guide will assist you in re-connecting to the SRVHS BYOD Wi-Fi with the new certificate settings. This guide is intended for students who have brought their personal device to school. If you need additional help please visit the library starting 12/1, during brunch, lunch, and after school. **This is not required for devices checked out from the school for the BYOD program.**

### MAC OSX:

- 1) Locate your Wi-Fi icon in the top right corner of your desktop.
- 2) Select the Wi-Fi icon to bring the drop down menu up.
- 3) With the drop down menu open select **Open Network Preferences** (A new window labeled **Network** will open.)
- 4) Select **Wi-Fi** from the left side window.
- 5) In the lower right corner of the **Network** window you will see a button labeled **Advanced...** select this and wait few a new window to open. (Note: You will need the administrator password to your computer to access the settings in this page!)
- 6) Within the **Network** window locate the **Preferred Networks** section which contains your saved networks.
- 7) Locate **SRVUSD-BYOD** from within the **Preferred Networks** window
- 8) Locate the Minus (-) symbol at the bottom left corner of the **Preferred Networks** window and delete **SRVUSD-BYOD**. (At this point you will lose your Wi-Fi connection which will complete the deletion process.)
- 9) Now that you have deleted your old Wi-Fi settings from your computer you can reconnect to **SRVUSD-BYOD** using your school provided username and password.(Don't forget to save your new network settings!)

### Windows 7/8/8.1/10:

Due to the drastic change in the Graphic user interface of the windows OS. This section will provide a broad how-to on removing your old Wi-Fi settings, which will cover all the operating systems listed above.

- 1) Select the start menu from the lower left hand corner of your desktop.
- 2) With the start menu open you will see a search bar towards the bottom of the start menu within you should see **Search programs and files**. Within this search bar type **Manage wireless networks**. **This search will only show the shortcut once the entire title as been entered!**
- 3) Once the **Manage wireless networks** window has opened (load time will vary on the pc!) locate **SRVUSD-BYOD** and delete it from your saved networks. (At this point you will lose your Wi-Fi connection which will complete the deletion process.)
- 4) Now that you have deleted your old Wi-Fi settings from your computer you can reconnect to **SRVUSD-BYOD** using your school provided username and password. (Don't forget to save your new network settings!)

## Chromebook OS:

For the chrome OS you will first need to log in to your personal account for your Chromebook. Once you have logged in, you may begin to follow the steps below.

- 1) First open the Chrome internet browser.
- 2) From within the Chrome browser select the menu shortcut from the top right corner in chrome.
- 3) A drop down menu will appear. Select **Settings** at the bottom of the drop down menu.
- 4) Once you have selected **Settings** you will be forwarded to the settings page within chrome.
- 5) Within the settings page locate the **Internet Connection** subsection.
- 6) Locate the **Wi-Fi Network** from the **Internet Connection** subsection.
- 7) Select the arrow to the right to open the drop down menu.
- 8) Select **Preferred networks**. A new window will open in the center of the chrome window.
- 9) Locate **SRVUSD-BYOD** from within the new window. A light grey **X** will appear to the right of the **SRVUSD-BYOD** Wi-Fi connection. Click the **X** to remove your old network setting for **SRVUSD-BYOD**.
- 10) Click done and close out of chrome completely
- 11) Now that you have deleted your old Wi-Fi settings from your computer you can reconnect to **SRVUSD-BYOD** using your school provided username and password. (Don't forget to save your new network settings!)
