



# The SAE Brings First-Ever Community Arts Festival to Pomona Arts Colony

**O**n Saturday, May 13th, The School of Arts and Enterprise (The SAE) showcased the talents, creativity and achievements of its students at The SAE Community Arts Festival. The inaugural event featured live theatre and dance performances, visual arts exhibitions and live vocal and instrumental music.

The festival drew more than 4,000 visitors to seven galleries in the historic Pomona Arts Colony and featured 42 performing arts performances at two stages. “The festival showcased the best of what we do artistically at The SAE,” said Phil Miller, the school’s Executive Producer. “And the response from the community was inspiring.”

The SAE Community Arts Festival is part of the school’s overall commitment to bringing the arts into Pomona—and beyond—throughout the year. “Our goal is to engage and benefit the broader community by utilizing the success of our unique brand of visual and performing arts instruction,” added Miller.

This summer, The SAE will offer its annual Summer Enrichment program (grades 3-8) and the return of its highly successful Summer Musical Theatre Workshop (grades 2-12)—both open to students from throughout the region. In addition, the school’s annual Summer Cultural Exchange Program will draw students from the U.S. and abroad.
