## Grade Check

Student grades will be checked on PowerSchool prior to the tournament to determine eligibility to participate. Students must have about 2.0 GPA to participate in the tournament.

## Behavior Agreement

Hutchinson Sports' players are representatives of our school. As such, they are expected to be models of appropriate student behavior.

As a team member on this campus, violations of school rules will be addressed as follows:

- Violations of school/class rules will result in a teacher log entry of behavior.
- If you receive 3 log entries for behavior, you will be placed on Behavior Probation.
- On probation, you will be given a five-day contract to complete. You must complete 5 consecutive clear days (good or fair behavior & completed/attempted class work) to be removed from probation.
- If you are on Behavior Probation and have not completed a clear behavior contract, you will not be able to participate in the tournament without a complete schedule teacher/admin recommendation.
