Dear Members of the Rock Springs Community,

The school year is off to a great start and we are excited to embark on another great school year. Every month, we will provide the community with a State of the School Address produced by our video production team which will be uploaded to our school website. This will provide a quick synopsis of the month ahead. We will also provide a more detailed newsletter that will outline our schools progress, successes and important dates to remember.

Parent Partnerships: We view parents as an integral part of the education process and value your input and suggestions. As the relationship between school and parents grows, so does student achievement. R and E Time: R and E stands for Remediation and Enrichment. We have built into our daily master schedule a 30 minute R and E time for our students and teachers. During this time, we are providing remediation for students who have not yet mastered the standards taught. Also we are providing enrichment opportunities to extend the learning of those students who have mastered the standards.

Student of the Week: We have started a new initiative at Rock Springs Middle to award a student of the week to both a male and a female student every Friday morning. Each student will be given a coupon to Chick Fil A of Smyrna for being named Student of the Week. We are trying to instill into our students Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Caring and Citizenship. When teachers or administration recognizes a student for demonstrating one or more of these traits the student will be nominated for this award.
