Family Athletic Events Program

Effective Thursday, September 21, 2006, all *paid* athletic events at Cheyenne, Legacy, and Mojave High Schools will be geared toward the family and community with an emphasis on individuals' entertainment, supporting our students, and everyone's safety. With the support of the Clark County School District's Athletic Department, the Clark County School District's Police Department, the North Las Vegas Police Department, and the community, the following will be implemented at all home (Cheyenne, Legacy, and Mojave High Schools) *paid* athletic contests (football, volleyball, wrestling, and basketball):

- All attendees must show picture identification for admittance into the venue.
- Only students from the respective schools playing (home and visiting schools) will be allowed into the *paid* athletic event.
- Students will be allowed in through the school's side entrance only.
- Non-students and younger students (8th grade and below) will be allowed admittance with an adult (21 years or older)
- Clark County School District dress code will be enforced (Example: hats, bandanas and do-rags will not be allowed).
- Backpacks, duffle bags, food or drinks will not be allowed into the athletic events.
- There will be no re-admittance into the *paid* athletic event if a student decides to leave during the event.
- Anti-social behavior will be prohibited and attendees exhibiting those behaviors will be removed or will be refused admittance.
- Students, who are removed from an athletic contest, this school year, will be prohibited from attendance, at athletic contests, for the remainder of the school year.
