

Indicator 11 ~ Timely Initial Evaluation Process

State Performance Plan Indicator 11 measures the percentage of children whose parental Consent for Initial Evaluation and Eligibility for Special Education/Initiation of Services was determined within 60 days. Be sure to include students who were determined to be eligible AND those who were **not** eligible for services. Do not include gifted students. It is the Case Coordinator's responsibility that the date of the Consent for Initial Evaluation and the Initiation Date (or Date of Meeting) is within the 60 day parameter allowed by the State of Kansas. - 2 - Must be Fund 1 - IDEA
- 3 - Evaluation Date must be within current FY
- 4 - Must have Service lines in the current FY
