## **Awards Day Criteria**

### **Student of Excellence Award**

- The principal will award one student from each team and grade level that stands out in the areas of citizenship and leadership.
- Students receiving this award will receive a medal.

### **Most Improved Award**

- This award is given to collaborative students from each team and grade level showing extreme improvement.
- The recipients are determined by teachers on each team.
- Students receiving this award will receive a medal.

### **Subject Area Awards**

- Each team will select two students from each subject area, with the exception of history.
- One award will be given to a student enrolled in a general education course and the other given to a student enrolled in a Pre-AP course.
- Seventh grade history teachers will select a student in civics and geography to receive an award.
- This award is based on academics, character and effort.
- Students will receive a certificate.

### **A Honor Roll (Principal's Awards)**

- Counselors will run a report and create a list for each grade level.
- Students must have a grade of 90 or above each nine weeks in every class to receive this award.
- Students receiving this award will receive a plaque.
  - In addition to being recognized at awards day, honor roll lists are displayed throughout the building each nine weeks.

### **A and B Honor Roll**

- Counselors will run a report and create a list for each grade level.
- Students must have a grade of 80 or above each nine weeks in every class to receive this award.
- Students receiving this award will receive a certificate.
  - In addition to being recognized at awards day, honor roll lists are displayed throughout the building each nine weeks.

### **Good Samaritan Award**

- The recipient of this award will be chosen by the principal. This individual is a stakeholder who has given selflessly to BMS.
- This individual will receive a plaque.

**Duke Tip (7<sup>th</sup> Grade)**

- Students who participated in the 2018 Duke University Talent Identification Program's 7th Grade Talent Search will be awarded with a certificate.
- Students who qualified for state recognition will receive a special recognition.

**Sports Med Scholar Athlete Award (8<sup>th</sup> Grade)**

- This award is given to one boy and one girl athlete.
- The award is given to students who play the most sports with the highest average.
- Students receiving this award will receive a plaque.

**Highest GPA (8<sup>th</sup> Grade)**

- The counselor will run a report to determine the individual receiving this award.
- The student receiving this award will receive a medal.
