MOBILE DEVICE AGREEMENT – ADDENDUM TO STUDENT AUP

The San Gabriel Unified School District (SGUSD) is dedicated to providing 21st century instruction to all of its students. We feel we must provide an environment that fosters and encourages the development of 21st century skills. In this learning environment, students actively engage in the integrated curriculum and have access to information and apply it to solve problems. Our students live in a world where they have immediate access to information anytime and anywhere.

BYOD stands for “**Bring Your Own Device.**” BYOD will allow students to bring their mobile devices to school for educational use under the direction of teachers and administrators. BYOD devices will supplement (not replace) computers in the classrooms and/or mobile carts. **BYOD is a privilege, not a right.** This privilege may be revoked for the student body as a whole or for students individually at the discretion of the administration. Therefore, it is important that our students use their devices responsibly, respect the property of others, and demonstrate that this use benefits them academically and helps them develop into good digital citizens. This is an addendum to the Student’s signed Acceptable Use Policy (AUP), which is on file with school administration, and does not replace that document in any way. All policies set in place in the Student AUP continue to apply when the student uses his/her personal technology device(s) on school property.

SGUSD is NOT responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged devices.

Personal technology devices brought on school property and used during and after school hours will be monitored while on the school network and subject to search by teacher, administrator or technology staff at any time. SGUSD does not guarantee the privacy or security of any item stored on or transmitted by any personal technology device. If found in violation of AUP policy, SGUSD Technology Dept. reserves the right to review Internet usage and access data files, stored data, emails, and other communications utilizing the District wireless network.

In order to access the student wireless network, students must register the MAC Address of the mobile device(s) and authenticate/login with the students username and password. All mobile devices will be checked for approved anti-virus, anti-malware, and anti-spyware protection.

All SGUSD students must adhere to the following standards of responsible use:

- Student mobile devices are not allowed to access the SGUSD regular network in any way.
- Students are not allowed to use peer-to-peer software, file sharing programs, telnet or messenger programs as well as other resource intensive applications.
- Students must not access, modify, download, or install computer programs, files or information belonging to others. Students shall adhere to all laws and statutes related to issues of copyright and plagiarism.
- Students are responsible for setting up and maintaining their devices. The District will not provide support for any BYOD devices.
- Students should not intentionally interfere with the performance of the wireless network and/or the district's overall network.
- Technology, including electronic communication, should be used for appropriate educational purposes only and should be consistent with the educational objectives of SGUSD.
- The District may review files and communications to maintain system integrity and ensure that users are using the system responsibly.
- Students must behave ethically and responsibly, even when technology provides them the freedom to do otherwise.
- Students assume the risk if they bring personal devices to school. The District will not investigate or look for lost/stolen devices.
- Students must not release personal information on the Internet or electronic communications
- Students must never log onto another student's account.
- Students must not create, publish, submit or display any materials/media that are abusive, obscene, sexually oriented, threatening, harassing, bullying, damaging to another's reputation, or illegal and will report any instances encountered.
- Students may not use devices to record, transmit, or post photographic images, sound or video of a person or persons on the campus during school activities and/or hours, unless otherwise directed by a teacher or administrator for specific educational purpose.
- Students acknowledge that the school's network filters will be applied to one's connection to the Internet and student will not bypass or attempt to bypass them.
- The school or District has the right to collect and examine any device that is suspected of causing problems that violate either a school rule or law of the state of California as defined in the California Educational Code.
- Violation of any of these standards stated in this agreement may result in suspension of computer use, Internet privileges and/or other disciplinary action.

I understand and will abide by the above policy and guidelines. I/we further understand that any violation of this agreement and any additional school or classroom guidelines may result in disciplinary action as per Policy BP 6163.4 which may include loss of BYOD privileges in SGUSD as well as other disciplinary action.
