## Dance DRESS CODE



### FORMAL DANCE DRESS CODE

#### Women:

- Strapless and spaghetti strap dresses are allowed but cannot be low-cut
- Dresses should not be more than 5 inches above the knee (including slits)
- Dresses may be backless as long as they are not cut below the naval
- No midriff-revealing dresses (including sides)
- Clothing must hide undergarments
- Material may not be see-through or nude fabrics
- No revealing bustlines
- Only small purses are allowed—please, no big bags or backpacks

#### Men:

- A tuxedo or suit with dress shirt, tie, dress pants, and dress shoes
- Dress pants only—no jeans, denim, shorts or cargos allowed
- Dress shirts with a collar
- Shirt must be tucked in and belt must be worn
- Dress or other clean, close-toed shoes only—no sandals
- Please do not bring big bags or backpacks

## DANCE CODE OF CONDUCT

- Tickets will be sold in advance at school and must be presented at the door to be allowed entry. On a limited basis, tickets may be sold at the door on the night of the event. Names of students who have purchased tickets will be kept and verified when tickets are presented.
- Students not following the dress code will not be allowed into the dance and refunds will not be given.
- Doors will close one hour after dance begins. Students may not leave the dance until thirty minutes prior to the advertised end time unless parent contact can be made. Once a student leaves the dance, they may not return.
- If the dance is held on the school campus, students are to be in designated dance areas. Students found outside of the designated areas will have their parents contacted to come pick them up.
- Dances are a time for fun with friends at a school-sponsored function. Therefore, any dancing deemed inappropriate is not tolerated. Students violating this rule may be subject to dismissal from the dance and will not be allowed to attend the next dance.
- NBH students may bring dance guests (1 guest per student) who are high school students between the age of 14-18. Guests must present ticket and ID to confirm identity and age in order to enter dance. Acceptable forms of identification are driver's license, school ID badge, military ID or other formal ID card. Guests must abide by the NBH Code of Conduct and Dress or they will not be admitted to the dance.
- Additionally, there is a zero tolerance policy on possession or use of alcohol, drugs, or other illegal substances at all school-sponsored functions. Students caught with or under the influence of any of these substances will be subject to discipline to the fullest extent according to School Board policies and will be remanded to the police.
- Students attending the dance must leave within 15 minutes of the end of the event to avoid fees at off-site events or preventing clean-up efforts of the school campus.
