- Diagnosis of Autism Spectrum disorder
- Autism, Asperger's, PDD-NOS, IDD with an IQ of 69 or below.
- If over 18 , proof of diagnosis is required.

Integral Care Mission:
Improving the lives of people who experience mental, emotional or substance use disorders and intellectual and developmental disabilities and delays.

Required Documents

- Proof of U.S. Citizenship or Immigration Status (birth certificate, passport)
- Social Security Card (If Applicable)
- Proof of Travis County Residency (Utility bill or a copy of your lease agreement)
- Proof of Income (pay stubs, Social Security award letter, other benefits)
- Proof of Medicaid (required)
- Legal Guardianship/Custody Documentation (if applicable)
- Photo Identification card or Driver's License (of the responsible adult)
- Proof of medical diagnosis and list of current medications (if applicable) Copies of previous Psychological Evaluations
- Full & Individual Evaluations from the school (including IQ scores) and ARD meetings
- Determination of Mental Retardation (DMR) Reports
- Neurologist Evaluation or Genetics Evaluations (Example, from Specially For Children)
- Comprehensive Diagnosis & Evaluation (D&E)
- Any documentation referring to a diagnosis of mental retardation or autism/pervasive developmental disorder (PDD)



Screening- Questions to ask yourself when considering IDD intake:

- In Special Ed? Under what condition?
ie. Intellectual disability or Autism
- Psychological or full individual evaluation if you have it.
- Evidence of existing records required.
- IDD intake requires a good informant about your developmental period to be present.
ie. Parent, grandparent, relative required.

What to expect at your appointment:

- You will meet with two people, an Intake Specialist and a Psychologist
- Intake Room is located on the 2nd floor (elevator available)
- Plan to be here 3 hours
- Children are welcome to bring snacks and favorite toys
- It's okay to take current medications before intake appointments
- The Intake Specialist will complete various forms with you and request your signature on many forms
- The psychologist will review any prior testing and administer any testing he/she feels will best assist with determining if you have a qualifying diagnosis for Integral Care IDD services.
