

PHILOSOPHY-GOALS-OBJECTIVES AND COMPREHENSIVE PLANS

District Technology Plan

The Board of Trustees recognizes that technology can greatly enhance the instructional program as well as the efficiency of district and school site administration. The Board also realizes that careful planning is essential to ensure the successful, equitable and cost-effective implementation of technology-based materials, equipment, systems and networks.

The Superintendent or designee shall develop a plan to address the short- and long-term technology needs of the District and provide for compatibility of resources among school sites, district offices, and other district operations. As a basis for this plan, the Superintendent or designee shall examine and compare the costs and benefits of various resources and shall identify the blend of technologies and level of service necessary to support the instructional program.

1. Focuses on the use of technology to improve student achievement and is aligned with the district's vision and goals for student learning
2. Contains clear goals for the use of technology based on an assessment of district needs
3. Addresses all components required for state or federal technology grant programs, administered by the California Department of Education, in which the district participates
4. Addresses the use of technology to improve district governance, district and school site administration, support services, and communications

The Superintendent or designee may appoint a technology committee to assist with the above investigations and determinations.
